## **ON AWAKENING:**

1) <u>Say the following prayer ASAP upon waking</u>: "As I consider my plans for the day, (starting first with last night's amends) - "I ask God that my thinking be divorced from self-pity, dishonest or self-seeking motives. I tell God that I will strive for Absolute Purity, Honesty, Unselfishness and Love by practicing Tolerance, Compassion, Patience, Humility, Forgiveness, Love and Good Will, I can employ my thoughts and actions to better serve Thee and my fellow-man. That if I face indecision, I will ask God to guide me to inspiration. I will relax, take it easy and not struggle. I WILL let those right answers come more as intuitive thoughts or decisions as time goes on."

I conclude by asking "for the Strength, Courage, Acceptance and Love to do God's will, not mine, as I go through the day and face indecision.. I will sit quietly and wait for direction." (Tip: Use a 3 x 5 index card or personal organizer to write down what comes to you in your meditation. Carry it with you throughout the day. As you complete tasks, cross them off. Each time you look at the list contemplate about any non-task oriented items like "be more patient with ......" or "practice more consideration with.....".)
